	H.	Any charitable organization receiving an allocation from an incorporated community chest or united fund, provided all of the following requirements have been met:		
		1) The chest or fund is complying with this section relating to registration and filing of annual reports with the Attorney General.		
		2) The charitable organization does not actually receive, in addition to an allocation, contributions in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) during the fiscal year.		
		 All of the fund-raising functions of the charitable organization are carried on by persons who are not paid for such services. 		
		If the gross contributions other than the allocation received by the charitable organization during any fiscal year of the charitable organization are in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), the charitable organization shall within 30 days after the date it receives the contributions in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), register with the Attorney General as required by this section.		
	I.	A local post, camp, chapter, or similarly designated element, or a county unit of such elements of a bona fide veterans organization, which issues charters to local elements throughout this state, or a bona fide organization of volunteer firefighters, ambulance companies, or rescue squads, or a bona fide auxiliary or affiliate of such organizations, provided all of its fund raising activities are carried on by members of the organization, family members of the members of the organization, volunteers, or an affiliate of the organization and the members receive no compensation, directly or indirectly, therefor.
